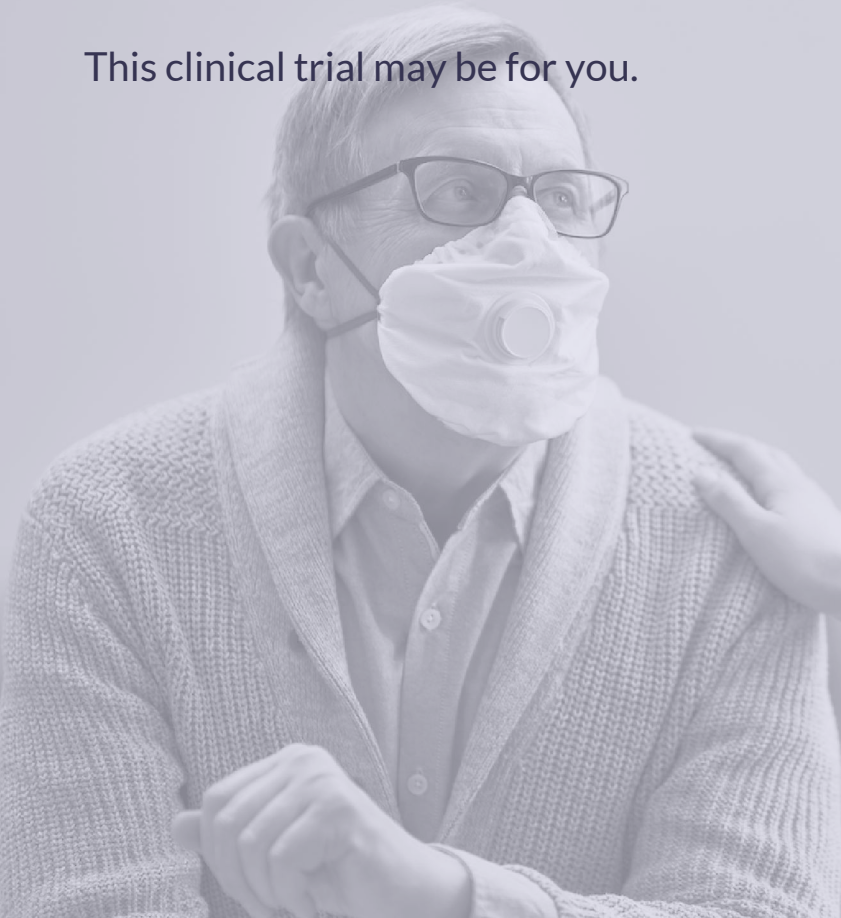

-  Cough for 1 year or longer
-  Non-smoker
-  Agree to attend 10 clinic visits within 3 months

- Receive study drug at no cost to them
- Help support research
- Receive \$250 in compensation per completed study visit

Is Chronic Cough Impacting Your Everyday Life?

If you're over 18 years old and have had a cough for more than 1 year that is unresponsive to treatment, this clinical trial may be for you.

About This Study

This trial is a phase II clinical trial designed to test how safe ADX-629 is and how well the body can handle taking it (called tolerability).

The trial will also look at whether the trial drug works (called efficacy) and the effect of ADX-629 on the cough-related quality of life.

Am I Eligible to Participate?

You may be eligible if you:

- Have had a chronic cough for more than 1 year that is unresponsive to treatment.
- Are a non-smoker.
- Have not used an ACE-inhibitor.
- Do not have any unstable or uncontrolled heart, liver, or kidney diseases/conditions.
- Agree to discontinue any cough-modulating medications.

What is Required to Participate?

Participation in the trial consists of three periods:

1. Study Treatment Period 1 (14 days).
2. Wash-out Period (14 days).
3. Study Treatment Period 2 (14 days).

Eligible Participants Will:

- Undergo study-related procedures and receive study drug (ADX-629) at no cost to them.
- Receive \$250 in compensation per completed study visit (Up to \$2,500.00 total).
- Support research and the development of new drugs.
